

Chancellor Gene D. Block

Dr. Gene Block has served as chancellor of UCLA since August 2007, overseeing all aspects of the university's three-part mission of education, research and service. A biologist, he holds faculty appointments in both the UCLA College of Letters and Science and the David Geffen School of Medicine, and he heads a research laboratory funded by the National Institutes of Health.

The priorities Chancellor Block has set for UCLA during his administration include academic excellence, diversity, civic engagement and financial security. He recently announced an initiative to raise \$500 million exclusively for student scholarships and fellowships over the next four years.

Previously, Dr. Block served as vice president and provost of the University of Virginia. He holds degrees from Stanford University and the University of Oregon.
